Change of alloy designations on actual fineness

Ladies and Gentlemen

For reasons of quality assurance and to comply with different standards in Europe, our 18 Karat alloys are, similar to the silver alloys, overalloyed with 0,1 percent for many years now.

As DIN EN ISO 9001 certified company we have to conform to the quality requirements for clarity and transparency of products. Therefore from 1<sup>st</sup> of October 2011 we change the alloy designations and the accounting mode on the actual fineness of the 18 carat alloys, for example from 750 GG 23 to 751 GG 23.

What does it mean for you:

- Technically nothing! The alloys, you are accustomed to, are alloyed in the composition of 751 parts of gold already for many years now.
- From 1<sup>st</sup> of October we will book on the accounts the actual fineness and print the actual designations. When ordering for example 100 grams of 751 gold, your precious metal account will be debited additionally with 0,1grams of fine gold.
